## CABIN COOKIN' BY MARGE



With the Holidays fast approaching you might be looking for something good and simple to make recipes for the occasions. This is a good one for scalloped corn and it can be doubled or tripled if you have a large group to feed.

### Scalloped Corn

1 Can Cream Corn (#2 size)	2-3 Doz. Soda Crackers (crumbled)
1 Can Whole Kernel Corn	1/3 Cup Half & Half (or Whole Milk)
1 Whole Egg	Salt & Pepper
	3TBSP Butter
	Diced Onion (optional)

Beat Egg in bowl with a fork until frothy

Add the corn and seasonings

Add chunks of butter, Half & Half and cracker crumbs

Top with additional cracker crumbs and dot with butter.

Bake 1 Hr @ 350

Serves 6-8

I have decided to have the traditional turkey for thanksgiving, along with baked squash and probably coleslaw for a couple of the items.
