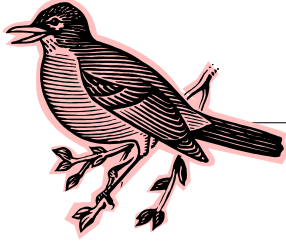

**BANANA SOUR CREAM COFFEE CAKE (12 C BUNDT)**

1/2 C. Butter	1 1/2 C. Sugar
2 Eggs	2 lg. Bananas, mashed
1 tsp Vanilla	1/2 C. Sour Cream
2 C. Flour	1 tsp. Baking Powder
1 tsp Baking Soda	1/2 tsp Salt
Topping:	
1/2 C. Chopped Nuts (pecans or walnuts)	1 1/2 tsp Cinnamon
1/3 C. Brown Sugar	(I doubled the topping)



Preheat Oven to 350. In a large bowl, cream butter and sugar. Beat in eggs for 4 minutes, beat in mashed bananas, vanilla and sour cream.

Mix dry ingredients together in another bowl (Flour, Baking Powder, Soda & Salt). Stir into creamy mixture, just to blend.

In a small bowl combine nuts, brown sugar and cinnamon.

Spray a 12 Cup Bundt Pan with non-stick spray, sprinkle 2 tsp of brown sugar mixture in bottom and sides of pan, shaking around to stick to pan.

Spoon 1/2 the batter into pan, then sprinkle rest of brown sugar mixture over, then spoon rest of batter into pan.

Bake at 350 for 45 min. Cool in pan 15 minutes. Turn pan upside down on serving plate.
